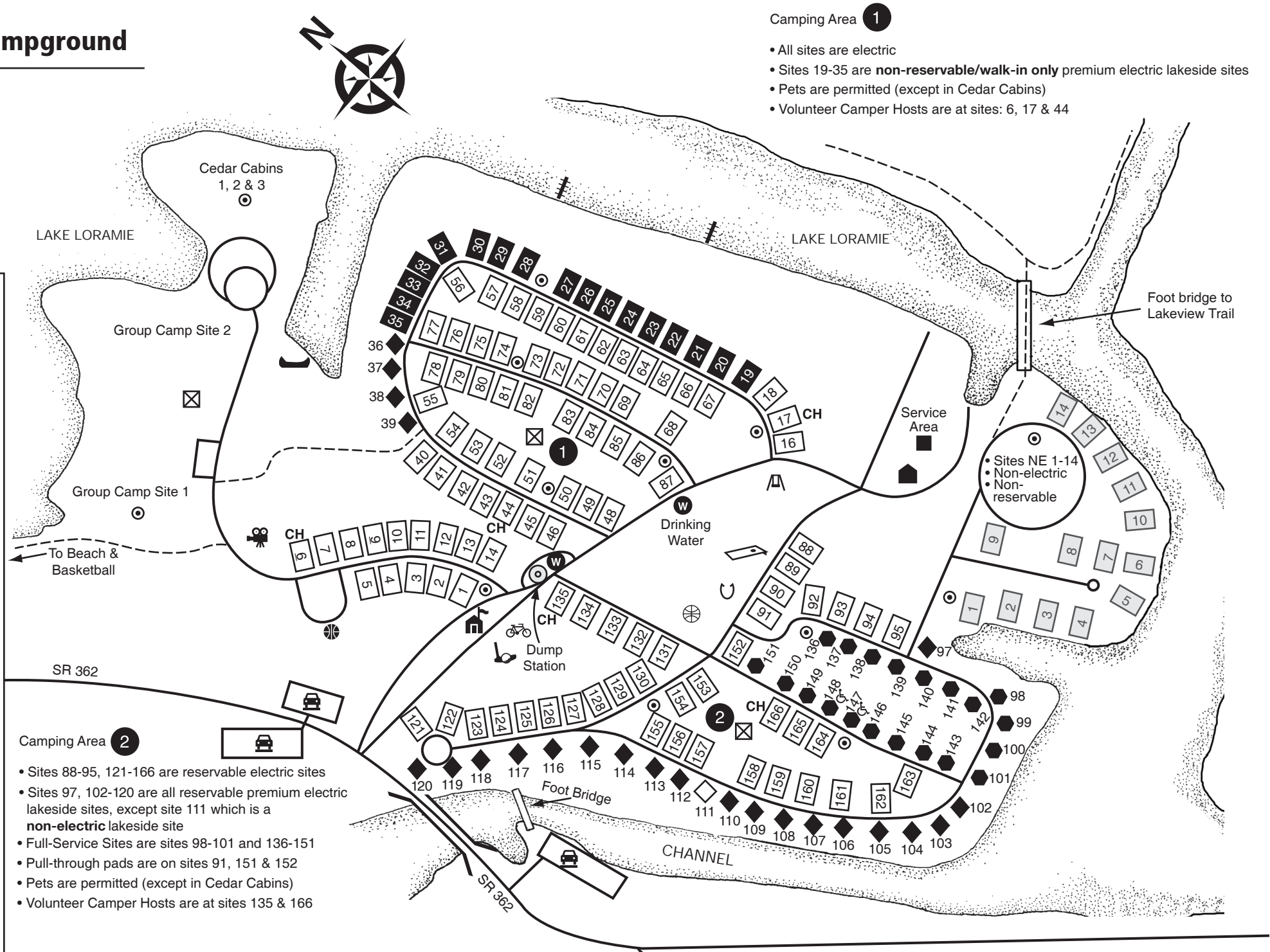

Camping Area **1**

- All sites are electric
- Sites 19-35 are **non-reservable/walk-in only** premium electric lakeside sites
- Pets are permitted (except in Cedar Cabins)
- Volunteer Camper Hosts are at sites: 6, 17 & 44

Camping Area **2**

- Sites 88-95, 121-166 are reservable electric sites
- Sites 97, 102-120 are all reservable premium electric lakeside sites, except site 111 which is a **non-electric** lakeside site
- Full-Service Sites are sites 98-101 and 136-151
- Pull-through pads are on sites 91, 151 & 152
- Pets are permitted (except in Cedar Cabins)
- Volunteer Camper Hosts are at sites 135 & 166

## CAMPGROUND RULES

Information about the park or local areas as well as general assistance is available from park officers or staff in the camp or park office. We hope you enjoy your stay at Ohio State Parks.

1. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
2. One camper and one other licensed vehicle are included in the registration fee. An additional licensed vehicle may be parked on a campsite by obtaining a car pass at the camp store office. Additional vehicles shall be parked in designated parking areas.
3. Any person under 18 years of age and desiring to register for a campsite must have a written consent of a parent or legal guardian. Additional information is required. Details may be obtained at the camp office.
4. A campsite shall not be occupied by more than six persons. In the case of one family with several children, the area manager may make exceptions to this limit.
5. Display of issued camping permits shall be made on the numbered site post when present, or in a conspicuous location upon the tent or trailer.
6. Bicycles after sunset are prohibited unless properly equipped as described in Ohio Revised Code 4511.56.
7. Motorized, non-licensed vehicles are prohibited.
8. **Camping is limited to no more than 14 days within any 30 day period.** No person shall stay in a Cedar Cabin for more than seven days within any 30 day period. (Exceptions may be made by the park manager.)
9. Any persons registering before 6 AM will be charged the rate for the proceeding night. The campsite must be vacated before 1 PM on the day the permit expires, or in the case of a Cedar Cabin by 11 AM. **Request for campsite renewals must be made prior to 1 PM.**
10. If you camp on an electric site, you must pay that rate, whether or not you use the electric service.
11. Fire is permitted only in the fire rings. Never leave a fire unattended. The collection of firewood or cutting of trees is strictly prohibited. **Do not move the fire rings.**
12. Please be considerate of others by keeping noise to a minimum between the hours of 10 PM and 7 AM. **For your safety and convenience, no visitors are permitted after 10 PM.**
13. Pets are permitted at any site and must be on a leash at all times. Sorry, pets are not permitted on the beaches, in restrooms, Cedar Cabins or other park buildings. Pet owners are required to clean up after their pets. Do not leave pets unattended. Pet owners shall have proof of vaccinations. Barking, noisy animals or animals that exhibit an aggressive nature will be removed from the park by their owners.
14. Smoking is prohibited inside state facilities (cabins, camp store, showerhouses, etc.).
15. No overnight tents in cabin area. Day-use screen tents allowed.
16. Back-in camping units only, except for pull-through sites 91, 151 & 152.
