Audubon Winter Bird Count - Hocking Hills State Park will again be participating in this year's annual Audubon winter bird count. Group 5 will meet at the naturalist office near Old Man's Cave starting at 8 AM and divide up our area to survey. The final tally-up will be at 3:00 PM at the Camp Otway Dining Lodge.
