- May 7** **Free Fishing Weekend, 2pm** Meet at the Nature Center. Learn about pole rigging, knot tying, casting, fish handling, habitat, local information and fish stories. This weekend is the only time people over 16 years of age do not need a fishing license. Fun for the whole family. Camp with us! - May 14** **Birds of Prey, 2pm** Learn about the feathered friends you may see in the park. See our resident Screech Owl and Red-tailed Hawk up-close. Learn why raptors are important and how you can help.
