Sat. June 4 Cicada Mania Continues, 10-11:30 am
Join the naturalist to celebrate the emergence of the 17-yr. cicada! We'll look and listen for these fascinating creatures while discussing their natural history. One mile hike with some up and down terrain. Meet at the lodge boat ramp (NOT the dock).

Sat. June 4 Sandstone Overhang Hike, 3-4:30 pm
This 1.5-mile hike will lead to a cool sandstone outcrop where we'll take a look at some non-flowering plants. Wear hiking boots and bring water. Meet at the lodge boat ramp (NOT the dock).

Fri. June 10 Forest Discovery Hike, 9:30-12 noon
Join the naturalist for this 3-mile hike to discover early summer's delights along the trail including wildflowers, ferns and sandstone outcrops. Wear hiking boots and bring water/ trail snacks. Meet at the Ranger Office.

Fri. June 10 Mammals Around Us, 3-4 pm
Join the naturalist for a close-up look at common Ohio mammals by examining their skins and skulls. Meet in the lodge lobby.

Sat. June 18 Tracks and Traces for Kids, 10-11:30 am
We'll learn about animal signs and make a track to take home! Meet at the lodge shelter house.

Sat. June 18 Nature Scavenger Hunt, 2-3 pm
Join the naturalist to search for plants and animals at the campground and nearby trail. For ages 5 and above. Meet at the campground amphitheater.

Sat. June 25 Mammals Around Us, 4-5 pm
Join the naturalist for a close-up look at common Ohio mammals by examining their skins and skulls. Meet at the campground amphitheater.

Sat. June 25 Strolling for Bats, 8:15 pm
Join the naturalist to look for bats as they begin their nighttime feeding. Meet in the lodge lobby.
