- Fri. Sept. 2 Reptiles R Us, 3- 4 pm**  
Come learn what makes reptiles unique and get a close up look at a special guest! Lodge lobby.
- Sat. Sept. 3 Creek Critters, 4-5 pm**  
We'll search for animals that call the creek home. Wear shoes you don't mind getting wet. Meet at the beach parking lot on the end away from the beach.
- Sat. Sept. 3 Campfire: Nocturnal Animals, 8 pm**  
Gather around the campfire for an evening focusing on Ohio's wildlife at night! Meet at the campground amphitheater.
- Sun. Sept. 4 Flowering Fall Beauties, 2 pm**  
Come out for a look at autumn's colorful landscape which includes the yellows and purples of wildflowers. We'll identify and enjoy field flowers and the insects they attract! Bring water. Meet at the Group Camp near Dock 3.
