### **Every Friday: Canoe or Kayak, 9am & 11am**

Sign up at the campground office, there are two time slots. This will be a quick start to paddling and will help you with proper techniques that will allow for a fun time exploring the lake. Please wear sunscreen and appropriate clothing. Life jackets and canoes/kayaks will be provided.

### **Every Saturday: Nature Hike, 7pm**

Join us on a leisure hike on the Educational Trail as we look for signs of animals that call the woods their home. Meet at the campground amphitheater. This trail is ½ mile and takes approximately an hour.

### **Sat. June 4: Animals of Ohio, 6:30pm**

Get a closer look at some of the animal that call Ohio home. Join us at the campground amphitheater to learn some interesting facts about the animals that are native to Ohio.

### **Sat. June 11: Reptiles of Ohio, 6pm**

Join the Naturalist to learn about our cold-blooded friends who call the park home. Meet at the campground amphitheater. Live critters will be present!

### **Sat. June 18: Nature's Decomposers, 6pm**

Meet at the campground amphitheater for a presentation on our forest floor when things die off, followed by an evening trail walk looking for some evidence of decomposers. Wear appropriate footwear and dress for the weather. Rain or shine. Easy hike. No pets, please.

### **Sat. June 25 Waterfowl, 6pm**

Join the Naturalist as we search the lake for signs of are feathered friends who are comfortable on the lake. Bring your favorite binoculars if you have them and a camera if you'd like. Meet at the campground amphitheater.
