- Fri Mar. 4** **8PM Maple Syrup Night Hike** - Meet at the **Blue Heron Trailhead** for a guided walk through an “old growth” forest after sunset. We will try to call in some owls and explore maple syrup production as we make our way to the sugarhouse.
- Mar. 5-6, 13-14** **50th Annual Maple Syrup Festival**
- Pancake Breakfast at the Lodge 8AM-1PM** \$6 for adults and \$5 for children 10 and under.
- Maple Syrup Tours Noon-4PM** Begin with a hay ride at the Pioneer Farm on Brown Rd. next to the Golf Course. Enjoy a hike through the “Big Woods”, a designated State Nature Preserve, and learn the art of maple syrup production as well as the cultural and natural history of the area. No dogs or other pets allowed on the tour. Food, beverages and maple syrup will be on sale throughout the day.

- 11AM Wildlife Invasion** - Meet at the **Lodge** for a look at some of Ohio’s wild animals.
- 2PM Wild Cat** – Meet at the **Nature Center** to watch the resident puma enjoy his lunch.
- Sun Mar. 27**
- 11AM Morning Hike** – Meet at the **Nature Center** for a hike thru a scenic area of Hueston Woods. Please wear appropriate footwear. Bring your vehicle; we will drive to the trailhead.
- 2PM Reptile Show** - Meet at the **Nature Center** to see some of our scaly residents.
