Fridays

Wildlife Invasion, 7-8pm. Get a closer look at some of Ohio's wild animals. Meet at the lodge.

Night Prowl, 9-10pm. Meet at the Hemlock Gorge Trailhead in Camp Area-A for an evening trail walk looking for signs of nocturnal wildlife. Wear appropriate footwear and dress for the weather. Rain or shine. Bring a flashlight. Easy hike. No pets, please.

International Migratory Bird Weekend Hike, 8-11am. Join us for a hike in search of warblers and other migratory birds. Meet at the covered bridge picnic area in Mohican State Park. Terrain is moderate. Wear comfortable hiking shoes and bring binoculars. No Pets, please.

Snake Saturday, 3-4pm. Meet at the Lodge for a presentation on snakes followed by a chance to meet one up close and personal.

International Migratory Bird Day Hike, 8-11am. More Warblers! Meet at the Lodge for a hike in search of warblers and other migratory birds. Terrain is moderate. Wear comfortable hiking shoes and bring binoculars. No Pets, please.
