### SEPTEMBER 2016

Friday

**Discovery Hike, 4-5:30pm.** Meet at the Check-in building located at the front of the campground for a 2 mile hike along the beautiful North Rim Trail. Wear appropriate footwear and dress for the weather. Water bottle and hiking stick is optional. This trail is rated moderate in difficulty. No pets, please.

Saturday

**Snake Saturday, 2-3pm.** Meet at the Lodge for a presentation on snakes followed by a chance to meet one up close and personal. A Mohican Lodge favorite!

**Night Prowl, 8-9:30pm.** Meet at the Hemlock Gorge Trailhead located at the front of the bridge to the cottages in Camp Area-A for an evening trail hike looking for signs of nocturnal wildlife. Wear appropriate footwear and dress for the weather. No flashlight is needed. No glow sticks or pets, please. This trail is rated an easy hike. All children must be accompanied by an adult.

**Turtles Rock, 10-11am.** Meet at the Lodge for an important chat about turtles followed by a chance to create a pet rock that's yours to take home.

**Archery, 3-4:30pm.** Meet in the parking lot across from class A campground. An exciting new opportunity to learn basic archery skills.

**Camp Walkabout 10am.** Meet at the Nature Center to start a hike around the campground in search of area wildlife including muskrats and mink that have been seen this year. We will also be on the lookout for eagles so bring binoculars if you have them. Easy hike.
