FEATURED EVENT: DOG PARK ETIQUETTE 11AM

The Friends of Mosquito Lake Dog Park will present a program on Canine Language and Play Behaviors, intended to teach dog owners to have a better understanding of their dogs feelings by observing their dog's body language.

The purpose of the program is to make it safer for you and your dog whether at home or at the dog park by increasing understanding of the dog's body language.

Jenny Flavery CPDT-KA-Trainer/co-owner of The Learning Dog LLC will present the program. This is a humans-only program, NO DOGS will be allowed. It is free and open to everyone. LOCATION: Dog park parking lot, large pavilion.

12:30 pm *Legend and Craft of the Rainstick:* The rainstick is a type of tubular rattle or sound producing instrument used in many cultures to bring rain to dry lands. Join the naturalist to construct your own rainstick. Material fee: \$2 donation. Please bring a hammer if you can.

3:00 pm *Blue Bird Box:* "The blue bird carries the sky on his back" –Henry David Thoreau. Learn about these and other special cavity nesters and help them by providing safe nesting sites for them. Make a nesting box to take home. Bring a hammer! Material fee is \$8.
