- Sat. Feb 13** **Sweetheart's Hike, 1pm.** Grab your sweetheart and join the Naturalists for a guided hike through a winter wonderland. Free and open to the public. Meet at the Nature Center.
- Sat. Feb 27** **Winter Hike, 10am-Noon.** Start at the Wellman Meadows Trailhead parking lot for a self-guided hike to Horseshoe Falls and our 103' swinging bridge. Warm up with a nice soup lunch at the Nature Center before going on to Crawdad Falls.
- May 27-30** **Memorial Day Weekend Camp Out.** A fun-filled weekend; make your camping reservation early.
- Sat. Jun 18** **Youth Fishing Derby.** Registration opens at 8am, fishing begins at 9am. Free and open to the public. At the Youth Fishing Pond. Instructors are on hand to help you learn the ins and outs of this lifelong hobby. Equipment and bait are provided while supplies last
- July 1-4** **4th of July Camp Out.** Celebrate Independence Day at Caesar Creek State Park; make your camping reservation early.
